Help I've been given RE

This session will give you an introduction to being an RE subject leader. We will be looking at: the role of the subject leader; why we teach RE - its aims and purposes; what we teach - our syllabus and planning and supporting colleagues; how we teach - creative ideas and resources including 'Understanding Christianity'; the impact of RE – assessment and evidence, monitoring and supporting and who what SIAMS & Ofsted are looking for.

SIAMS for Schools

SIAMS stands for the Statutory Inspection of Anglican and Methodist Schools. This is also known as a Section 48 inspection. This webinar is for headteachers, RE leaders, Collective Worship leads, governors and those who lead on the Christian character of a church school or Trust. In this session we will explore the new 2023 SIAMS Framework.

Collective Worship

This Collective Worship training is for governors, clergy and staff who are involved in leading developing, and monitoring collective worship in their school. It aims to provide the opportunity for you to explore good practice in planning, resourcing, and monitoring collective worship in your school or trust and to share ideas with colleagues.

Heads and Chairs autumn briefing

Termly update for leaders in church schools and academies. We invite the Headteachers, Senior Leaders and Chairs of Governors of all our Church schools to attend a briefing led by members of our Senior Leadership Team, School Advisers from the Diocese of Bath and Wells Education Department and invited speakers. These briefing events are an opportunity to hear updates from us about what we are working on alongside our local authority colleagues, MATs and to hear updates about any changes on a national level.

There is a different agenda each term, covering a variety of subjects, ranging from the statutory to the inspirational. As well as input and updates from us, at these events there is the opportunity for Heads and Chairs to meet together and share ideas. We welcome and encourage you to give us feedback on your experiences and how we can support you and your Church School.

Theologically Rooted Christian Vision

SIAMS 2023 asks about your school's 'theologically rooted Christian vision'. This session is aimed at schools who are looking to revisit their vision or who have already an established school vision.

It will support school leaders to articulate the context of your school, and to think about how to respond to this theologically. How do you then formulate an effective theologically rooted Christian vision and support your school community in understanding this.

Understanding Christianity Day

This is a popular resource to support the teaching of Christianity in Religious Education, used in most of the church schools and academies across the country. It meets all the expectations of the RE Statement of Entitlement and the SIAMS inspection process.

Spirituality in Schools

How can we recognise and encourage the creation of space for spiritual development in our schools, enabling all pupils and adults to flourish?

This webinar provides the opportunity to explore what spirituality in the school context and the SIAMS expectations for church schools, recognising and valuing spirituality and implementing a school policy for spiritual development. We will share some good practice from schools within our diocese and also some key documents that will support you in your development.

SIAMS Forum

This is an opportunity to share experiences, anxieties, and helpful tips on preparing for SIAMS with colleagues. At this forum there will be opportunity to: discuss questions about SIAMS related matters, including self-evaluation; share experiences, helpful tips and best practice; have space to explore and discuss the challenges of the SIAMS inspection and discuss the impact of the changes and developments to the SIAMS inspection process.

Headteacher Retreat

Would you welcome and benefit from the opportunity to step away from school for a short period of time, to reflect on the things that motivate and sustain you in your vocation as a Headteacher?

This free, one-night residential retreat at Ammerdown Retreat Centre might be the very opportunity you need to consider and replenish your own wellbeing and in order to lead and inspire others effectively.

Heads and Chairs in-person briefing

We invite the Headteachers, Senior Leaders and Chairs of Governors of all our Church schools to attend an in person briefing led by members of our Senior Leadership Team and School Advisers from Bath & Wells Education Department at Flourish House in Wells.

We are dividing these briefings into the three archdeaconry areas of the Diocese of Bath and Wells and will have an address by the archdeacon for your area. These events are an opportunity to hear updates from us about what we are working on alongside our local authority colleagues and to hear updates about any changes on a national level.

We are currently looking at venues so that these can be based within each Archdeaconry. Further information will sent to confirm the venue and date early January 2024. The Wells briefing will be at Flourish House on 18 June 2024.

New Chairs: Leading in a Church school

For new and recently appointed chairs and those who wish to update their knowledge.

This course, written by an experienced Chair of Governors, will give you all the skills and information you need to get started and be effective immediately. The course will include looking at the key roles and responsibilities of a governing body with specific reference to the Chair's role. There will be advice and guidance on issues Chairs of Governors find themselves faced with.

Clerk's Forum

Our clerk's forum is held once every long term to provide an opportunity for networking and to discuss key issues facing Clerks. Hear from speakers chosen by discussions in previous forums. Focused briefings specifically for Clerks from the diocesan team, often on subjects requested at previous forums. Opportunities to share best practice

Foundation Governors' Forum

Our termly governor forum is aimed at all those serving as governors in our church schools and has been designed with a view to providing attendees with the opportunity to network, share best practice and to hear about any hot topics. Each forum will have a theme, often with a guest speaker, as well as time planned in for that valuable networking opportunity.

Church School Governance Part 1

This two-part training session is suitable for foundation representatives and those in other governance roles in both maintained and academy church schools (including school governors and trustees). Please note, this course is mandatory for all newly appointed foundation representatives.

Session one is a general course that covers the importance of good governance in any school, focusing on key governor activities. It is suitable for someone new to governance or as a refresher for a more experienced governor. We will also cover key areas that are unique in a church school and start familiarising the delegate with areas that will be covered in greater depth in the second session. This session will provide participants with practical knowledge that they can apply to their setting.

Church School Governance Part 2

This is part two of a two-part course aimed at those in governance roles in both maintained and academy schools. Session two aims to provide opportunities to ask questions, network and discuss with fellow governors, and apply church school governance to your own context.

Church School Governance for renewing foundation governors

A session designed to provide a refresher for experienced foundation representatives in maintained and academy schools. It is a compulsory module for renewing foundation governors. This session will cover a brief update on the team and any recent new initiatives, answering any questions foundation governors may have. Updates and discussion on a range of subjects relevant to the foundation governor e.g. SIAMs, governor monitoring, environment, recruiting governors, building diverse boards etc.

Church School Governance for Members and Trustees

An introduction to governance as a Trustee or a Member within a Multi Academy Trust. Suitable for those who have been newly appointed, or those looking for a refresher, and who would like to know more about their strategic responsibility for governance across their trust.

Forum for Members

A chance for the Diocesan Corporate Member (DCM) to really understand their role and the interface with the Diocesan Board of Education and the Education Department particularly with the changes contained within the new church articles.

Forum for Trustees

This forum, facilitated by the diocesan education team, is an opportunity for director/trustees of Multi-Academy Trusts to meet to discuss current issues facing them particularly with regard to church school distinctiveness and to network with others within the wider diocesan area.

Governor Monitoring Part 1: An Introduction to effective Governor Monitoring and how to use it in your school.

This session is aimed at governors and school leaders who want to understand more about what constitutes good quality governor monitoring. The session is designed to be interactive, with participants encouraged to consider the themes alongside their own practice. This session is designed to compliment Governor Monitoring 2 SIAMS, Collective Worship and RE so if you are inexperienced at governance, we would recommend doing this one first.

Governor Monitoring Part 2: How to Governor Monitor SIAMS, Collective Worship and RE

This session is aimed at governors, clergy and school leaders who want to understand more about effective governor monitoring for SIAMS, Collective Worship and RE.

The session is particularly useful for schools that have not yet developed their monitoring as a church school or have this as a SIAMS development area. However, it is also aimed at those new to governance, particularly foundation governors, or for clergy and school leaders starting out in monitoring their church school

Margaret has been pivotal in creating the new SIAMS framework and will be exploring spiritual leadership in the context of our church schools, fully aware that school leaders reflect a wide range of spiritual and faith perspectives.

Paul Rusby

Paul Rusby has worked in schools for over thirty years, twenty of which he has spent as headteacher of three different Church of England schools. He has supported schools in his role as a National Leader of Education, Primary Consultant Leader and School Improvement Partner. He is passionate about Church of England schools and the impact that they can have on the flourishing and wellbeing of pupils and adults.

Paul has a deep interest in spirituality. Blending together his theological training, SIAMS experience and leadership roles in schools, he provides school improvement coaching and consultancy support. He leads retreats and Christian meditation sessions using poetry, music and the landscape to support people's spiritual growth.
