Respect for each other

Please...

- 👂 Respect that we are a Christian organisation and that this will shape what we do
- 👂 Treat everyone fairly and equally as you would like to be treated yourself
- 👂 Avoid rushing around unless it is part of an organised activity
- 👂 Don't hurt each other physically or emotionally (**bullying** of any kind will not be tolerated)
- 👂 Respect other people's space and refrain from acting in a sexual manner
- 👂 Respect other people's beliefs, morals and values
- 👂 Be honest and don't take anything that does not belong to you
- 👂 Refrain from swearing or using God's name in disrespectful ways
- 👂 Videos or pictures should not be taken without permission or posting anything on social media
- 👂 Don't use mobile phones when important information is being given out

Respect for the building

Please...

- 👂 Respect the building and the equipment
- 👂 Use the bins for litter and chewing gum
- 👂 Only use the toilets for what they are designed for
- 👂 Keep the fire exits clear


Respect for the law

Please...

- 👂 Remember all Fuse activities are smoking free
- 👂 Refrain from bringing any type of weapon to the youth group
- 👂 Do not bring illegal substances such as drugs or alcohol to the youth group
- 👂 (If a young person is thought to be under the influence of any illegal substances or alcohol we will involve parents / guardians)

Consequences of negative behaviour

If a young persons behaviour is not acceptable, they will be:



Physical or verbally aggressive behaviour or **bullying** towards staff or young people is not acceptable, neither is deliberate damage to equipment or the building. Culprits may be asked to leave immediately and may be given a **'Time Out Ban'**.
