

# Giving for Life

## Sample cards for use by people who give to their Church by Standing Order

A supply should be kept in a small basket where hymn-books, etc are given out. The worshipper takes one and puts it in the plate when the collection is taken, avoiding the embarrassment of waving the plate by. After the service, the cards are put back in the basket by the money-counters, ready for next time.

They can easily be made up in Microsoft Word or Publisher.  
For durability, they should be on good coloured card.  
If you have access to a laminator, they can last a very long time.
