*Our Magnificat parishes are those which are high on the Index of Multiple Deprivation.

Sunday, 16 November	Loving God, we come before you seeking your divine protection. Guard our hearts, minds and bodies from harm. Protect the vulnerable, comfort the fearful, and strengthen those who keep watch over others. Make us mindful of our duty to safeguard one another, reflecting your care and compassion in all we do.
Monday, 17 November	God of love, we give thanks for all those offering pastoral care across our diocese, in so many contexts. Give them discernment in their speaking and their silence so that all they encounter may sense your generous love.
Tuesday, 18 November	We ask that your guiding Spirit meets us where it is needed to bring peace and healing in body, mind and Spirit, knowing that our relationship with you leads to wholeness and flourishing as our Lord Jesus came to show us.
Wednesday, 19 November	Christ the Cornerstone, as the Diocesan Advisory Committee meets today, we pray for their conversations about how our historic church buildings may best fit your mission and serve their communities. We ask you to guide their discussion and decision making in all things.
Thursday, 20 November	Loving God, as representatives from our Magnificat parishes meet today, we pray that it is a time of refreshment and encouragement; a time where vision is renewed and hearts and minds are set even closer to your will for all the precious souls in their care.
Friday, 21 November	Faithful God, as we approach Advent and make plans for Christmas in churches, homes and schools, inspire us afresh to tell the story of the shepherds, the angels and our Saviour, born in Bethlehem.
Saturday, 22 November	Gracious God, as Diocesan Synod meets today, give wisdom to those who lead us, and ears to hear your Word. Give courage to those who speak their truth and give peace as we work to grow and show your Gospel here today.
Sunday, 23 November	In a season of waiting and expectation, we ask your blessing, Loving Jesus, upon expectant parents, and your guiding arms to surround and encourage all who nurture children and young people.

God of Wonder, be with those involved in Journey to Bethlehem this week and next, as the story of Jesus' birth is brought to life on farms around our diocese. We ask your blessing on school children and staff, church volunteers and storytellers, farmers and their animals.
